



NOTICE TO LIGHTNING RIDGE RESIDENTS

BOIL WATER ALERT LIFTED FOR LIGHTNING RIDGE

The boil water alert on the Lightning Ridge Town Water Supply has been lifted by Walgett Shire Council effective immediately.

This action was taken following advice received from the NSW Health Service following the last two samples had been free of E-Coli contamination.

Walgett Shire Council General Manager Don Ramsland said today, "I am pleased that the boil water alert has now been lifted. However, weekly testing of the Lightning Ridge Town Water supply by an independent laboratory in Sydney will continue in the interests of community health".

Council wishes to apologise to the residents of Lightning Ridge for any inconvenience caused by Council having to impose this measure.
