#### 2012/2013 Allocations – NSW Rural Fire Fighting Fund

The Minister for Police and Emergency Services, The Honourable Michael Gallacher MLC, has recently approved allocations for the 2012/13 Rural Fire Fighting Fund, which supports volunteer brigades who protect your local community.

The Rural Fire Fighting Fund for 2012/13 is \$263.7M. Highlights of this year's Fund include:

- \$35.9M funding for mitigation and hazard reduction works, including State Mitigation Support Crews, which assist volunteer brigades in completing hazard reduction and the ongoing AIDER program which assists infirm, disabled and elderly residents prepare for bush fires;
- The ongoing upgrade of the NSW RFS radio and paging network infrastructure (\$12.9M);
- \$11.2M funding for firefighting equipment and Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), including \$2M for the provision of new structural firefighting garments to ensure the best possible protection for our volunteers;
- \$30.05M for new and refurbished tankers and other vehicles;
- \$10M for aviation resources allowing for a fast response to fires; and
- \$9.9M for volunteer brigade stations and Fire Control Centres.

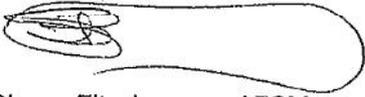
In addition, the NSW Government has accepted the recommendation from the Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal regarding fees associated with the operation of the Government Radio Network (GRN). The 2012/13 budget incorporates the reduced contribution of \$7.669M in this respect.

The NSW RFS has taken on board recent feedback from councils and improved the format of the summary page attached, to allow greater visibility of the Volunteer and Statewide Support Services (VASS).
