On the morning of the event Mother Nature had other plans delivering steady rainfall, the night before, hindering the morning proceedings. After much deliberation and ensuring we provided a COVID safe environment, abiding with COVID regulations, the 2022 Australia Day Citizenship and Awards Ceremony was held at the new multi-million dollar PCYC complex giving many of the community their first look inside the new facility.

Mayor Jane Keir OAM then welcomed and introduced our Australia Day Ambassador for this year, renowned children's author, Ms Susanne Gervay OAM.

The day witnessed over 150 plus Shire residents and some visitors engage in a well-received awards and citizenship ceremony.

This year Council had 19 nominations in the following categories: Health Award, Business Award, Volunteer of the Year, lifetime Achievement Award, Young Citizen of the Year and Citizen of the Year.

HEALTH AWARD:

The aim of this award is to recognise the achievements of a professional, working in the local health industry who has made a significant contribution to the local community in the fields of nursing, medicine, allied health or health research. There were 3 nominations received for this category. VOLUNTEER OF THE YEAR

The aim of this award is to recognize those who have made an outstanding contribution to our community who, through their volunteer works, have shown a commitment to the growth and prosperity of Walgett Shire. Council received 4 nominations for this category, Lynn Bartleson, George Siegwalt, John Randall and Nicholas Nelson. *The Volunteer of the Year Award was Nicholas Nelson*

YOUNG CITIZEN OF THE YEAR

The aim of this award is to recognize the significant achievements of a young citizen and their impact on the broader community. Council received 1 nomination for this category with *Jack O'Brien being awarded the Young Citizen of the Year for 2022*.

An accomplished athlete who did not let the remoteness of his surroundings nor lack of prior experience deter him from attaining great achievements in his chosen sport. As an outstanding role model to all young people in the community; while at home, Jack seeks to involve himself in community sporting events and also encouraging others to do so and chase their dreams.

CITIZEN OF THE YEAR

The aim of this award is to recognize the outstanding contributions made by a citizen to the local community. The award is reflective of quality of service and the individual's acts of compassion, generosity and citizenship. Council received 3 nominations for this award: Diane White, Barry Henry and Trent Swinton. *The winner of the prestigious Citizen of the Year was Mr. Trent Swinton*
