The Delivery Program addresses the objectives and strategies of the Community Strategic Plan and identifies specific actions Council will undertake to achieve this. The program also allocates responsibilities for each activity in each set of actions along with budget items for the three (3) years and the Operational Plan for 2022/23. The previous Delivery/Operational Plan is available on Council's web site and residents are asked to make comment on the strategies and actions, do they address the challenges and issues currently faced by the community, and are the service levels satisfactory to meet community expectations. Community assistance is paramount to developing these important Integrated Planning and Reporting documents she said.
