Subject: Rating of Land Affected by the Removal of Water for Valuation Purposes

Summary:

This report recommends that Council does not defer utilisation of water exclusive values for rating purposes for the 2007/2008 rating year.

Comments (including issues and background):

Amendments have been made to the Local Government (General) Regulation 2005 to assist Councils in rating those properties defined as 'irrigable' under section 529 (4) of the *Local Government Act 1993*.

This amendment is subsequent to the enactment of the *Local Government and Valuation of Land (Water Rights) Act 2005*, which among other things has resulted in the separation and removal of the value of water access entitlements from land titles.

The Local Government (General) Amendment (Rates for Irrigable Land) Regulation 2007 consists of three parts:-

- 1. **Clause 120A** Rating of irrigable land the subject of certain post 1.7.05 supplementary valuations.
- 2. Clause 120B Matters to which Council may have regard in sub-categorising irrigable land.
- 3. Clause 120C Transitional nature of clauses 120A and 120B.

Clause 120A provides for the deferral of the utilisation of water exclusive values for rating purposes until such time as the Council has received a general revaluation.

It is recommended that Council does not apply this clause due to the equitable model proposed and the positive feedback received from various external bodies.

A general revaluation will be received by Council in 2008 and the existing model will be reviewed once the general revaluation is received.
