COMMUNITY FACILITIES TO RECEIVE A FACELIFT IN WALGETT

Two of the wonderful community facilities in the Walgett Shire Council area will be upgraded, thanks to almost \$170,000 worth of funding from the NSW Government.

Of the funding, \$72,822 has been allocated towards the fencing of playspace in Gray Park, as well as the replacement and enhancement of furniture in the park to make it more user-friendly for families and visitors.

The Norman 'Tracker' Walford Walkway, which is named after an amazing man, will receive \$95,661 worth of upgrades, including resealing of the entire 712m path, an upgrade of signage and some additional seating.
