### THREE POSITIVE COVID-19 CASES ISOLATING IN WALGETT

As at 12:10pm Wednesday 8th September 2021, three individuals infected with Covid-19 are undertaking self-isolation in Walgett.

The individuals are self isolating and their health and well being requirements are being addressed by NSW Health and their employee.

I appreciate in community questions may be arising around venues of concern - the Public Health Unit are currently undertaking investigations to establish any relevant venues of concern. Upon receipt of any further information with respect to venues we will disseminate immediately.

By wearing a face mask, washing our hands and physical distancing we can all do our part in reducing the chance of the virus spreading throughout community. Please remember to use the QR Code or sign into any shop, retail outlet or commercial premise that you enter.

It is a timely reminder to encourage anyone who believes they may be suffering from any Covid symptoms to please come forward for testing. For the remainder of Tuesday testing is being undertaken at the Walgett MPS.

On Wednesday 8 September and Thursday 9 September a pop up drive through Covid Testing Clinic will be operational outside the Walgett Swimming Pool upon Montkeila Street, Walgett.

Anyone who attended these venues is a casual contact and must get tested and self-isolate until they receive a negative result. If your date of exposure at this venue occurred in last 4 days, you must get another test on day 5 from the date of exposure. Wear a mask around others and limit your movements until you get another negative result. You should continue to monitor for symptoms and if any symptoms occur, get tested again
