- Mayor reported to Council regarding activities undertaken during March 2022, including the attending community consultation meetings with the Councillors, General Manager and Directors who met with locals to discuss Council's Operational Plan and Delivery Program for this term of Council
- Manager, Community Development, George McCormick reported to Council on community engagement activities through the months November 2021 to February 2022; including events such as Love Where You Live program, Australia Day Awards, International Women's Day and Harmony Day 2022.
- As at 28<sup>th</sup> February 2022, Walgett Shire Council has spent \$12,997,405.00 on capital and maintenance works in the areas of quarry management, fleet management, water & sewer works, parks & gardens, Walgett Weir and engineering administration.
- As at 28<sup>th</sup> February 2022, Walgett Shire Council has spent \$356,955 and committed a further \$364,090 in flood restoration works.
- Council agreed to make a submission to Whiddon Group for the acquisition of the property at 146-148 Fox Street, Walgett (being Lot 3 DP803866).
- Council agreed to accept Batterline Earthmoving Pty Ltd's tender for the reconstruction and sealing of 54.96kms of Come By Chance Road.
- Council agreed to accept Batterline Earthmoving Pty Ltd's tender for the reconstruction and sealing of 10.6kms of the Burranbaa Road between Collarenebri and Lightning Ridge.
