Walgett PCYC to have several features that benefit the community

The walls are up and the new PCYC Walgett is a giant step closer to opening!

NSW Upper House MP, Sam Farraway MLC said the multi-function facility will be a great asset for Walgett's 2,000-strong community.

Features in the 1,800-square metre facility include an air-conditioned indoor multi-purpose sports court, a multi-purpose activity space catering for gymnastics, trampolining, climbing, ninja monkey bars, and parkour, a functional gym with weights, a youth hub area and rainwater harvesting.

The \$7.5 million joint initiative between the NSW Government, PCYC NSW and Walgett Shire Council is due to be finished later this year in time for the Christmas school holidays.

This facility will be a major development for Walgett and enable PCYC to expand its programs, including Fit4Work, Fit4 Life and other police and indigenous programs designed to engage with youth while also providing a facility to address health, well-being and public order issues.

When the initial PCYC funding was announced, chief executive officer Dominic Teakle said the funding would help strengthen the relationships we facilitate between young people and police officers.

"[It] ensures youth and the community have modern and safe facilities to participate in a range of sporting and recreational activities," he said.
