

What is happening?

MINOR FLOODING POSSIBLE AT GOANGRA ON WEDNESDAY

Recent rainfall has caused significant river rises along the Namoi River, which has the potential to cause Minor flooding at Goangra.

The Namoi River at Bugilbone peaked below the Minor flood level (4.90 metres) on Friday 03 September. The main flood peak is now approaching Goangra where Minor flooding is possible on Wednesday.

The Namoi River at Goangra is currently at 5.25 metres and rising slowly.

What we are expecting:

- The Namoi River at Goangra may peak near the Minor flood level (5.50 metres) during Wednesday.

At this height:

- Water may start to flow across the low-level causeway east of the approach to Goangra Bridge on Goangra - Yarraldool Road.
- Goangra - Yarraldool Road may close at the western approach to Goangra Bridge.

What you need to do:

- Stay up to date with information. Listen to flood warnings and follow advice on how to protect yourself, family and property.
- People working or camping along the Namoi River should monitor river heights and relocate to higher ground.
- Farmers and landholders are advised to relocate livestock, pumps and machinery to higher ground.
- Motorists are advised to take extreme care as there may be water flowing across causeways and local roads.
- Do not drive through floodwater as floodwaters may be deep, fast flowing and contain debris and is a major cause of flood related deaths.

Safety is your highest priority - Never walk, drive, or play in floodwaters.

For emergency help in floods and storms, call the NSW State Emergency Service on 132 500. In life threatening situations call triple zero (000) immediately.
