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Summary:

The report aims to provide Council with appropriate information to adopt concept plans for the upgrading of the Collarenebri Showground facilities.

Background:

In late 2019 Council received notification of funding for the upgrade of the Collarenebri Showground through the Murray Darling Basin Authority program. A milestone for the project is the adoption of plans and scope of works for the various elements.

Current Position:

Concept plans and a scope of works for the various elements have been prepared for circulation to contractors requesting quotations.
